# **Back the Badge**

I was proud to co-sponsor and the Senate passed four bills benefiting law enforcement officers, the biggestbeing SB 160, better known as the "Backthe Badge Act." Police officers have recently been at the forefront of violencein our country and this is just one measure we passed to help protect Thisbill seeks to impose harsher them. punishments against those who commit violent actsagainst our officers. The bill calls for additional punishments for the crimesof obstructing police officers, blocking highways and being involved in aprison riots. Under current law, someone who harms a public safety officerreceives a sentence of 5 to 20 years in prison. However, SB 160 imposes amandatory minimum sentence by preventing any part of the five year minimum sentence from being suspended, deferred or probated. This bill represents ourappreciation for all our officers and our support of all they do to keep ussafe every single day.



# **Surprise Medical Billing**

Another important bill I co-sponsored and supported passed the Senate and protects Georgia's citizens against surprise billingby providers, hospitals and insurers for out-of-network services. Under Senate Bill 8, aprocess for appeal through the Georgia Department of Insurance would be created, and a database for usual and customary costs of services to be maintained bythe Georgia Department of Community Health would be established. This shouldhopefully reduce the number of citizens who experience the frustration and burden of surprise billing.



## **Firefighter Cancer Bill**

Along with passingbills on the floor, the committee I chair passed out HB 146 which would protectanother underserved group of people: my fellow firefighters. This bill would providethem with insurance coverage if they are diagnosed with a certain kind ofcancer. This bill is important not only for firefighters, but also theirchildren. We lose too many firefighters to cancer every year; andthis serves as a small token of appreciation for everything they do to protect us. This billwould provide immediate relief to families and would take a burden off thesebrave men and women.

Supporting our public safety officers and firefighters will benefit our children and our children's children. They are the backbone of our communities and makesacrifices every day to ensure our safety. It was an honor to pass legislation that shows our unwavering support for these brave men and women.
