Election Update

There are many questions surrounding the November election. Clearly Fulton County and some others need significant improvements. I will be sponsoring major election reform legislation this coming year. There are serious concerns and the Senate is convening an oversight committee right away to investigate. I sincerely appreciate Attorney General Chris Carr highlighting GA election law regarding residency requirements for voting in the January 5th runoff. Many of us are concerned about this issue and this confirmation provides assurance that anyone who registers to vote or attempts to vote knowing they do not meet the residency requirements will be guilty of a felony under Georgia law.

There will be a runoff election on Tuesday, January 5th for US Senator Perdue, Loeffler and Public Service Commissioner Lauren McDonald all of whom I fully support.
