2024 Legislative Session

The legislature updated the redistricting maps per Judge Jones order earlier this month and will return to the second year of the legislative biennial on Monday, January 8th at your Georgia State Capitol.

Property Tax Reform

The current property tax system is broken. Local governments arbitrarily value homes which change regularly based on state law. Several years ago, we reset property taxes in North Fulton for the cities, county, and schools. In addition, we capped increases to 3% per year. With the recent 40-year high inflation this saved homeowners significantly. We are working on a similar solution for Cherokee & Cobb Counties. In addition, I am working on a statewide solution

to bring transparency, logic, and property tax reductions.

Fulton County Jail Update

As the Senate Chairman of Public Safety, I appointed a subcommittee to fully investigate the root cause and the solutions available to us.

We are continuing to conduct the investigation and have additional meetings scheduled this year and into 2024. This is an important issue and must be fixed permanently.



Lowering the Income Tax - Again!

I was proud to stand with Governor Brian Kemp, Lt. Gov Burt Jones and other legislative leaders to announce the acceleration of the income tax reduction.
